




recently restored Temple of Bacchus.





WHERE THE WALK IS A WORK AT ART

Painshill is a beautiful award-winning 18th century landscape garden. The 158 acre estate has something for everyone and makes a great day out. Created by the Hon. Charles Hamilton between 1738 and 1773, after he was inspired by landscape painting, it is a living canvas full of stunning views and dramatically placed garden buildings.

veteran English Oak and the Great Cedar.
