



Covid Statement & Post Lockdown Guidance

In line with HSE guidance, the Education Team has refreshed our existing risk/benefit assessment, identifying protective measures which will be adhered to throughout. This has been carried out by the Painshill Head of Education in consultation with other relevant parties as required. What follows are the steps we have taken to meet public health guidelines.

- Numbers will be restricted to a bubble of 15 attendees as per government guidelines for out- of- school groups.
- Attendees will book for a block of 3 days to ensure no additional attendees have exposure to the bubble and the attendees are consistent.
- Volunteers and casual staff will not be used to ensure no additional staff have exposure to the bubble and staff are consistent.
- All activities will be consistent with the government guideline regarding health, social distancing and hygiene.
- Additional provision will be made for handwashing and general hygiene.
- All staff and participants will follow social distancing guidelines.
- An entrance and exit one way system will be used by parents or guardians at drop-off and pick-up.
- In the event of lateness or cancellation, guardians must call Adam on 07940 087147.
- We recommend the same guardian drops-off and collects their child(ren), but this is not essential.
- Management of the reception area to ensure families do not gather or breach social distancing guidelines.
- PPE to be provided to staff. We do not foresee a need for additional PPE as long as social distancing can be met.
- Due to social distancing guidelines, our First Aid Policy has been reviewed. We cannot apply medical equipment (e.g. plasters, water) unless the injury is serious and intervention is needed to prevent it worsening. In this case additional PPE will be used. For minor injuries, equipment can be given to the child or a member of their house hold to apply and its use explained by the first aider. We may phone guardians to report injuries or discomfort if we feel it to be appropriate.
- We cannot offer refunds or amendments to bookings. Bookings are for consecutive days only and cannot be transferred to other weeks. In the event of a cancellation, we may be able to offer discounted tickets for future Painshill education events later in the year but this cannot be guaranteed.
- If the attendee or a member of their household exhibits symptoms of Covid-19 they must not attend and must follow government guidelines.
- The government encourages you to avoid other out-of-school clubs or gatherings in the same week.
- If our staff or members of their household exhibit symptoms of Covid-19 the camp will be cancelled from immediate effect. You will receive a full refund but Painshill will not be liable for additional expenses incurred.
