## ACCESSIBLE ROUTE

The accessible route, about 1.5 miles (2.4 kilometres) long, avoids the paths with steep slopes that can be encountered throughout the rest of Painshill.

### PLEASE TAKE CARE

Painshill is an historic site and has some areas of uneven surface. Extra care should be taken, especially around the lake edge.

We have a limited number of manual wheelchairs available free of charge at Painshill, available on a firstcome, first served basis. Please call us if you would like to pre-book this service.



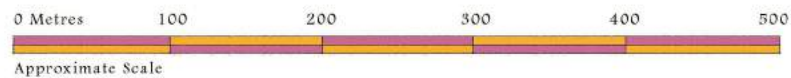
Assistant dogs are admitted into all areas.
